Road teams to be hired in the interim. Won’t change the grading schedule but will be more efficient. • Nerriga Rd \$10m grant. Design almost complete. Start in Feb 25, complete Dec 26. This will see all of Nerriga Rd sealed. • 2 x IWCM plans (Palerang and Queanbeyan) may be merged. Harmonisation will be looked at by Council in the first half of 2025. • * Bill Waterhouse asked if we could have a mechanism through the Council depot for rural residents to buy water legally. • Palerang water charge increase – would it be reviewed? Intention to review in context of rate review but not on its own. • Waste Strategy review – consultation later this year. 2025 strategy to be adopted by 30 June 25. • 88 Wallace Street – currently in design phase.
